Dear Barbra,

Aus-Tex explorations agrees to all the Conditions of Approvals as set forth by the COGCC which included:

Due to the location being in a sensitive area the following conditions of approval will apply:

· Operator must implement site-specific best management practices in accordance with good engineering practices, including, but not limited to, construction of a berm or diversion dike, site grading, or other comparable measures, sufficient to protect intermittent stream located 230 feet east of the staked oil and gas location from a release of drilling, completion, produced fluids, and chemical products.

Due to the likely hood of oil being received in the pit and exceeding 10,000 ppm TPH the drilling pit must be lined Fenced and netted. The pit will be closed through the form 27 process.

Due to the likely hood of oil being received in the pit and exceeding 10,000 ppm TPH an approved Pit Permit (Form 15) will be required prior to pit construction. The form 15 shall include a pit management plan.
