Based on review of information presented on your behalf by LT Environmental on May 10, 2012, it appears that no further action is necessary at this time, and COGCC approves the closure request. However, should future conditions at the site indicate contaminant concentrations in soils exceeding COGCC standards or if ground water is found to be significantly impacted, then further investigation and/or remediation activities may be required at the site. John,  
LTE would like to submit the following No Further Action determination request on behalf of PDC. Please review the attached supporting documentation for activities associated with a dump line release at the above referenced subject site located in the SESW Section 7-T6N-R64W. Soil and groundwater were

impacted at the site from the release. Approximately 1,000 cubic yards of impacted soil and 2,964 bbls of impacted water were removed from the site and transported to licensed disposal facilities. Analytical results indicated that the final extent of the excavation associated with the dump line release were in compliance with COGCC Table 910-1 Concentration Levels. Monitoring wells were installed in April 2011. Groundwater samples were collected on a quarterly basis until analytical data was in compliance with CDPHE Regulation 41 Standards for four consecutive quarters.

As four consecutive quarters of CDPHE Reg 41 compliant groundwater analytical results have been achieved, PDC is requesting a No Further Action determination for this site.
