

This letter documents our discussion regarding the above-referenced Oil and Gas Facility located within the NWNW 36, Township 26S, Range 67W, Huerfano County.

Pursuant to COGCC Rule 306.c (consultation with CDOW) and 1202.b (oil & gas location on SWHA), and based on the presence of a **Pronghorn antelope winter concentration area**, CDOW has consulted with you on the above-referenced facility.

Energy Oil and Gas is aware that the site lies within a Pronghorn antelope winter concentration area and you have indicated that your preference is not to drill within the colder, winter months thus avoiding any wildlife conflicts. Therefore, CDOW will recommend expedited permit approval to the COGCC.
