On June 19, 2012, the Weld County Dept. of Public Health & Environment conducted a routine inspection of the Noble Energy Production Inc. Northern Centralized E & P Waste Treatment Facility, located at 24336 Weld County Road 46, Weld County, Colorado. The purpose of the inspection was to assess the facility's compliance with the Approved Site Specific Development Plan and Use by Special Review Permit Number 1517 (SRP-1517) and applicable Weld County Code. Based on the inspection, the facility was inactive and in compliance.

Please be advised, pursuant to 23-4-860 "Abandonment" of the Weld County Code, if the Use by Special Review is discontinued for a period of three (3) consecutive years, it shall be presumed inactive or abandoned. These same code provisions further state, that the County shall initiate an administrative hearing to consider whether to grant an extension of time to commence the use or revoke the use.
