Please note that the Form 27 Site Investigation and Remediation Workplan for closure of the pit must be submitted for Director approval prior to commencing work. This allows COGCC Staff to work with you to ensure soil (and groundwater samples, if necessary) are collected from the appropriate locations and that waste from reclamation of the pit is handled appropriately.

Per my voice mail Friday afternoon, July 27, 2012, COGCC staff discovered an unpermitted workover pit on the Little Beaver Unit #41 well location. In addition, oil was present in the pit. Workover pits require approved Pit Permits prior to construction, and the presence of oil on any pit other than a properly lined, netted, and permitted skim pit is a violation of COGCC Rules. COGCC has issued the attached Notice of Alleged Violation.

Per my voice mail on July 27, the oil must be removed within 24 hours. The remaining violations should be addressed in accordance with the attached NOAV. I will mail a hardcopy of the NOAV today.
