Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) staff has reviewed the Spill/Release Form 19 submitted on 08/15/2012, as well as the additional information submitted with your email dated 09/26/2012. The documentation was submitted by Tasman Geosciences on behalf of PDC, for the above referenced site. Based on review of data presented, it appears that no further action is necessary at this time at this site. However, should future conditions at the site be discovered of contaminant concentrations in soils exceeding COGCC standards or if groundwater is found to be significantly impacted, COGCC may require that further investigation and/or remediation be conducted.
