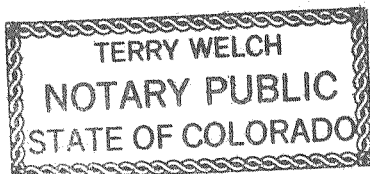

### NOTICE OF EMERGENCY HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND  
TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

As required by Rule 318 of the Rules and Regulations of the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission, all wells must be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line. The Director may grant exceptions to this rule provided that waivers or consents signed by the lease owner toward whom the well location is being moved, be filed with the Commission, and/or provided that if the owner of the proposed well is also the owner of the lease on the property toward which the well is proposed to be moved, a waiver shall be obtained from the mineral interest owner of the offset lease. If a waiver cannot be obtained or the partners cannot reach an agreement, the operator may apply to the Director for relief from this requirement.

On October 5, 1992, Washington Energy Exploration, Inc., by its attorney filed with the Commission an application for an order to allow the Pinon Federal No. 12-28 Well to be drilled at an exception location 1524 feet FNL and 620 feet FWL in the SW1/4 NW1/4 of Section 28, Township 5 North, Range 98 West, 6th P.M., due to topographic and surface considerations, for production from Dakota Formation.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the above, has scheduled the above-entitled matter for hearing on:

Pursuant to said hearing in the above-entitled matter at the time and place

aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operations of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute. Any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or to intervene should file with the Commission a written protest or a notice to intervene no later than October 13, 1992 briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. Such interested party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or notice to intervene to the person filing the application. An original and eight (8) copies, accompanied by a fee of forty-five dollars (\$45.00) shall be filed with the Commission. In accordance with the practices of the Commission, should no protests or interventions be filed in this matter by October 13, 1992, an administrative hearing will be scheduled prior to the above hearing date.
