#### NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:  
On February 15, 1993, the Commission adopted the D-J Basin Policy for  
Cause Nos. 499, 232, 407, 250, 496 and 493, which among other things,  
established guidelines for requiring the posting of Damage Bonds and Recla-  
mation Bonds for wells drilled or to be drilled in lands covered by the above-  
listed Cause Numbers.

On March 8, 1993, Delores Martindale as owner of land in the NE 1/4 of  
Section 36, Township 4 North, Range 67 West, 6th P.M., by her attorney, filed  
with the Commission, an application for an order to be issued requesting that  
Elk Exploration, Inc. be required to raise the bond requirements for the Sur-  
face Damage Bond, as the damage that will be incurred as a result of oil and  
gas operations will exceed the amount of the statewide Damage Bond cur-  
rently in place; and that Elk Exploration, Inc. be required to post a Reclama-  
tion Bond conditioned that the lands affected by operations associated with  
the drilling and operating of such well(s) shall be stabilized and reclaimed in  
accordance with the Commission's rules.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Oil and Gas Conservation Commis-  
sion of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the above, has scheduled the  
above-entitled matter for hearing on:

Pursuant to said hearing in the above-entitled matter at the time and place  
aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders  
as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in  
the operations of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.

Any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or  
to intervene should file with the Commission a written protest or a notice to  
intervene no later than April 13, 1993, briefly stating the basis of the protest  
or intervention. An original and eight (8) copies, accompanied by a fee of  
forty-five dollars (\$45.00) shall be filed with the Commission. Such interest-  
ed party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or notice to inter-  
vene to the person filing the application.
