IN THE MATTER OF THE UNDERGROUND DISPOSAL OF WATER BY INJECTION IN THE SPINDLE FIELD, CAUSE NO. 1

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Basin Operating Company has filed with the Commission documents to inject produced water in the proposed Carl A. Miller d-9 Well located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 5, Township 1 North, Range 67 West, 6th P.M., said well to become an injection well in the Sussex Formation for the purpose of disposing of water produced from wells in the Spindle Field. In accordance with Rule 326.e. of the Rules and Regulations of the Commission, notice of the application has been given to each surface owner within 1/4 mile of the proposed well. Any person who would be adversely affected by the proposed operation may file with the Commission a request for a public hearing. The Commission may hold a hearing if it finds a significant degree of public interest.

The staff reported to the Commission at its May hearing that there is a significant degree of public interest in the above-described matter. The Commission was requested to hold such a hearing by officials and residents of the City of Dacono, and officials from the towns of Frederick, Firestone and Ft. Lupton.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the above, has re-scheduled the above-entitled matter for hearing on:

Pursuant to said hearing in the above-entitled matter at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders at it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operations of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.

Any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or to intervene should file with the Commission a written protest or a notice to intervene no later than June 14, 1993, briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. Such interested party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or notice to intervene to the person filing the application. An original and eight (8) copies, accompanied by a fee of forty-five dollars (\$45.00) shall be filed with the Commission.
