 TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:
 On April 20, 1992, the Commission adopted Rule 603.b., into the Rules and Regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission which allows tracts of land to be designated as high density area upon application, notice and hearing before the Commission.
 Under Colorado Revised Statute 34-60-116(2) the Commission was authorized to establish exploratory drilling units for the purpose of obtaining evidence as to the existence of a pool and the appropriate size and shape of the drilling unit to be applied.
 On March 24, 1994, William E. Franz, Jr., by his attorney, filed with the Commission an application for an order to establish all that part of the NW1/4 of Section 14, Township 7 North, Range 66 West, 6th P.M., Weld County, lying West of the Larson and Molander Seepage Ditch and the Eaton Consolidated Seepage Ditch as a high density area.
