NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:
On March 22, 2000, Tyler Rockies Exploration, Ltd. ("Tyler") submitted to the Commission an application pursuant to Rule 325 for a permit to dispose of produced water into the Cowell No. 1 Well located in the NE1/4 NW1/4 of Section 31, Township 3 South, Range 59 West. On March 30, 2000, Ronald D. Furk submitted a protest to the application filed by Tyler.

On May 22, 2000, Tyler, by its attorney, filed with the Commission a verified application for an order authorizing the disposal of produced water into the Cowell No. 1 Well located in the NE1/4 NW1/4 of Section 31, Township 3 South, Range 59 West. Tyler proposes that the produced water will be injected into the "J" Sand Formation at a depth of 8239 feet to 8270 feet.

This matter was originally scheduled for the July, 2000 hearing but could not be heard at that time due to the Commission's full docket; accordingly, the hearing in this matter has been continued.
