### NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO  
WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On September 23, 2002 the Commission issued Order No. 1V-238 which found Monument Gas Marketing, Inc. ("Monument") in violation of Rule 319.a.(1) for the Bucklen #2-34 Well, located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 34, Township 17 South, Range 46 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. Monument was ordered to re-enter the Bucklen #2-34 Well and properly plug the well no later than February 1, 2003.

On October 24, 2002, Monument Gas Marketing, Inc. filed with the Commission a Motion to Reconsider to either amend or repeal the subject Order No. 1V-238 and find that Monument is not in violation of Rule 319.a.(1) for the Bucklen #2-34 Well. Monument is prepared to offer testimony from seven witnesses, to submit logs and cross-sections of numerous wells showing that Monument plugged the Cheyenne and other aquifers properly, and to submit COGCC approved plugging procedures on surrounding wells.
