

Apollo Waste Management Plan

Apollo Operating intends to dispose of used drilling fluids, stimulation fluids, produced water at an approved Class II UIC Facility permitted by COGCC in Weld County, which includes its own facility known as the Apollo 15-18 I Class II UIC well in NE/4 Section 18, Township 6 North, Range 63 West.

Apollo Operating will utilize a closed loop drilling system in order to minimize drilling cuttings and waste water. However, drill cuttings are planned to be land farmed and/or used for land abatement at related Apollo facilities and/or properties or at a COGCC approved land farm.

All waste will be visually inspected to determine if it is reasonable to dispose of said waste as described above. All waste is stored onsite until properly disposed of.

It is difficult to estimate volumes on a well by well basis, however, in general terms Apollo typically experiences the following:

- Drill Cuttings from closed loop-less than 2 tons
- Used stimulation fluids- less than 700 bbl
- Produced water-approximately 20 bbl/month
