When picking up 2 3/8 tubing from a trailer and running in the well the first joint fell from the elevators and landed on the completions contractor's right foot. The impact caused a laceration to the big toe which required sutures to close. The contractor was wearing steel toed safety boots. The contractor will be unable to return to work for several days due to swelling and to watch for infection. The incident occurred at 9:00 AM on October 21, 2012. Shaun Kellerby with the COGCC was notified of the incident by e-mail on October 21, 2012 at 4:22 PM.
