TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS
AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:
The Commission issued its orders
number 3-12 and number 3-13 on
October 11, 1955 and order number
3-14 on November 21, 1955 all of
which orders contain the following
rule: "(a) Such wells be located on
a designated drilling unit of not less
than 320 acres (order number 3-13,
640 acres) of land, more or less, ac-
cording to legal subdivisions of the
United States Land Surveys in which
unit all of the interests are consoli-
dated by a pooling agreement or oth-
erwise, and on which no other well
is completed or approved for com-
pletion in the same pool."
The Commission is of the opinion
that the above rule should be revised,
amended or deleted.
