All persons interested in such matter are invited to appear and be heard on the above date.

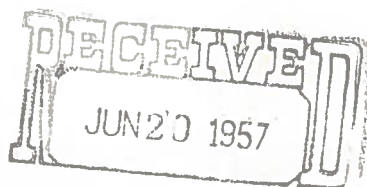
