
The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 8, Underground Injection Control Program has reviewed a March 2011, Step Rate Test (SRT) submittal from Kinder Morgan CO<sub>2</sub> Company, LP (Kinder Morgan) conducted on the Woods No. 3 (MWD-1) injection well. The March 2011, SRT data is approved and increases the maximum allowable injection pressures (MAIP) for the following three Kinder Morgan Class I disposal wells in Montezuma County, Colorado:

PERMIT NUMBER	WELL NAME	MAXIMUM ALLOWED INJECTION PRESSURE, psi
CO10787-00053	Hovenweep, HWD-1	1,000
CO10789-00420	Woods No. 3, MWD-1	1,000
CO10788-00054	Yellowjacket, YWD-1	1,000

As discussed in the December 27, 2010 letter, the MAIP demonstrated for the Woods No. 3 (MWD-1) well is extrapolated to the Hovenweep (HWD-1) and Yellowjacket (YWD-1) wells. This increase of MAIP is being made under the authority of 40 Code of Federal Regulations §144.41 (e) and terms of the EPA's December 27, 2010, approval of Kinder Morgan's SRT Procedure. In the future should you choose to request a modification to the approved MAIP new supporting data, such as a new SRT, will be required. In order to inject at pressures greater than the permitted MAIP during any future test(s), you must receive prior authorization from the Director.
