The public comment period for these permits ended on June 11, 2012. No comments on the draft permits were received during the public notice period therefore; the effective date for these EPA UIC Permits is the date of issuance. All conditions set forth herein refer to Title 40 Parts 124, 144, 146 and 147 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) and are regulations that are in effect as of the effective date of the permits.


These permits are issued for ten (10) years of the original issuance or reauthorization date, unless terminated. The permits will expire on the date identified in the table above, or upon delegation of primary enforcement responsibility for the UIC 1422 Program to the State of Colorado, unless that state has adequate authority and chooses to adopt and enforce a permit as a State Permit.


The permits will be reviewed at least every five (5) years to determine whether action under 40 CFR 144.36(a) is warranted.

Please note that under the terms and conditions of this final permit you are authorized only to construct the proposed injection well. Prior to commencing injection, you first must fulfill all "Prior to Commencing Injection" requirements of the final permit, Part II Section D.1 and obtain written Authorization to Inject from the EPA. It is your responsibility to be familiar with, and to comply with, all provisions of your final permit.
