A protest to the granting of the application was filed on January 27, 1978 by Charles A. Underwood. PLACE Room 110, State Centennial Building, 1313 Sherman Street, Denver, Colorado 80203 At said hearing, applicant and protestant and any other interested persons are requested to appear and present testimony in order for the Commission to determine if approval for said water disposal well should be given. Pursuant to said hearing in the above-entitled matter, at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operation of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.
