NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, upon its own motion, has set the above entitled matter for hearing on:

PLACE: Room 132, State Services Building, 1525 Sherman Street, Denver, Colorado

On May 12, 1963, the Commission issued its Order No. 16-1 which, among other things, defined the Frenchman Creek Field and established 160-acre drilling and spacing units for production of gas from the "J" sand formation underlying said area.

As a result of engineering and geological information presently available, subsequent development of this area indicates that the following lands should be deleted from said Frenchman Creek Field:

Township 8 North, Range 50 West, 6th P.M.
Section 29: SW ¼
Section 30: S ½

Pursuant to said hearing in the above entitled matter, at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operation of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.
