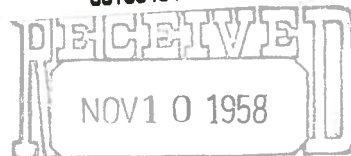

The Commission has previously is-
sued its Order No. 24-1, dated No-
vember 3, 1953, which, among other
things, defines the Bonham Field as
follows, to-wit:

North Half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) Southwest
Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) West Half of the
Southeast Quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of
Section Twenty-six (26), all of
Section Twenty-seven (27), North
Half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section Thirty-four
(34), and North Half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of
Section Thirty-five (35), Town-
ship Eight (8) North, Range Fif-
ty-five (55) West, 6th P.M., Logan
County, Colorado.

Due to the present status of de-
velopment of this field, it appears
that it may be advisable to redefine
the field and remove the spacing
regulations of Order No. 24-1 on por-
tions of all of the area set forth
above.

Pursuant to said hearing in the
above entitled matter, at the time
and place aforesaid, or at any ad-
journd meeting, the Commission
will enter such orders as it deems
appropriate to prevent the waste of
oil and gas, either or both, in the
operation of said field, and to carry
out the purposes of the statute.
