Just to let you know, we have decided to plug and abandon both Linker wells. We will be closing the pits and the location.

I am meeting next Tuesday with two possible remediation contractors at the Linker location. We will then choose one of the contractors and I will file the Form 27 so we can begin remediation work. Whichever method we choose for the Linker, we will also use to remediate the Rudnik soil pile and any contamination from the Rudnik skim pit. Once we have chosen a remediation method and contractor (in the next two weeks) I will file Form 27's for both of those projects.
