

NOTICE OF HEARING BEFORE THE OIL AND GAS CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF COLORADO CAUSE NO. 26 IN THE MATTER OF THE PROMULGATION OF FIELD RULES TO GOVERN THE SPACING AND DENSITY OF OIL AND GAS WELLS IN THE ADENA FIELD, MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO. TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, upon its own motion, has set the above-entitled matter down for hearing on: DATE: Monday, June 20, 1955 TIME: 10:00 a.m. PLACE: Pine Room, Albany Hotel 17th and Stout Streets Denver, Colorado The Commission has heretofore issued its Order No. 26-12, which provides in part that the Order shall be in effect for a period of Six (6) months, commencing January 1, 1955. All operators and owners of working interests, and all persons interested in the said field are hereby required to appear at the hearing as set forth above, and to show cause, if any they have, why the Commission should not issue an order continuing the provisions of Order No. 26-12, or an order similar thereto. Pursuant to said hearing in the above-entitled matter, at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operation of said field.
