Dear Mr. Wyatt:

In accordance with Rule 305.e.(1).B of the Rules and Regulations of the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC), this letter serves as a 30-day notice by Koch Exploration Company, LLC of its intention to commence operations for the drilling of a well on the above – referenced location. Koch’s operations are estimated to begin within 180+ days from the date of this letter, pending receipt of required permits and drilling rig availability. COGCC regulations provide that the surface owner may waive the 30-day notice requirement.

In accordance with Rule 306.a of the Rules and Regulations of the COGCC requires written notice from the surface owner to request or waive a consultation meeting with Koch Exploration Company, LLC concerning the location of the above-referenced well and all associated equipment, or designate a representative for surface consultation.

Also enclosed is a copy of the COGCC’s brochure describing surface owner rights and responsibilities.

As the surface owner, it is your responsibility to notify any affected tenant farmer, lessee, or other party that may own or have an interest in any crops or surface improvements that could be affected by these proposed operations.
