IN THE MATTER OF THE PROMULGATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF FIELD RULES TO GOVERN OPERATIONS IN THE LOST CREEK FIELD, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:
The Oil and Gas Conservation Commission, on its own motion, will consider issuing an order establishing 160-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the "J" Sand, common source of supply underlying the following described lands in Weld County, Colorado, to-wit:
Township 2 North, Range 62 West
6th P.M.
Sections 2 through 9
Township 3 North, Range 62 West
6th P.M.
Sections 32 through 35
and further providing that said units should consist of a quarter section, according to the governmental survey thereof, and that the permitted well for each such unit be located no closer than 600 feet from the boundaries of the unit, and no closer than 1850 feet from another gas well producing from the same source of supply.
