NOTICE OF HEARING

On February 17, 1976, the Commission issued its Order No. 304-1 which, among other things, established 320-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of gas from the Sussex formation underlying certain lands in the Hambert Field, Weld County, Colorado.

On October 1, 1976, Amoco Production Company, filed with the Commission an application for an order further extending the limits of the Hambert Field to include the following described lands in Weld County, Colorado, to-wit:

Township 4 North,  
Range 65 West, 6th P.M.

Section 6: All  
Section 17: All  
Section 20: All  
and further providing that such additional area be made subject to the provisions of Order No. 304-1, and that Well No. 1 Edward Hemple, located in the NW 1/4 of said Section 20 be the permitted well for the designated unit consisting of the W 1/2 of said Section 20.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the above, has set the above entitled matter for hearing on:

Pursuant to said hearing in the above entitled matter, at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operation of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.

Any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application should file with the Commission a written protest no later than December 15, 1976, briefly

stating the basis of the protest, and such interested party shall at the same time serve or mail a copy of the protest to the person filing the application.
