BEFORE THE OIL AND GAS CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF COLORADO CAUSE NO. 304

IN THE MATTER OF THE PROMULGATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF FIELD RULES TO GOVERN OPERATIONS IN THE HAMBERT FIELD, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO

NOTICE OF HEARING TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On February 17, 1974, the Commission issued its Order No. 304-1 which established 320-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of gas from the Sussex formation underlying certain lands in the Hambert Field, with the permitted wells located in the NW 1/4 and SE 1/4 of each section and no closer than 990-feet from the boundaries of the quarter section upon which each is located. The spaced area was extended by Order No. 304-3.

On August 15, 1977, the Commission issued its Order No. 304-4 which established 160-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of gas from the Sussex formation underlying Section 24, Township 4 North, Range 66 West, 6th P.M. The remaining lands are still subject to said Order Nos. 304-1 and 304-2. In addition, it was further ordered that a hearing shall be held in six (6) months, at which time the Commission shall review data from additional development in the field to determine whether the 320-acre drilling and spacing units, as established by said Order Nos. 304-1 and 304-3 should be continued for the remaining lands.

The lands included in the spaced area of the Hambert Field, Weld County, Colorado are described as follows:

- 160-acre drilling and spacing units. Township 4 North, Range 66 West, 6th P.M. Section 24: All 320-acre drilling and spacing units. Township 4 North, Range 65 West, 6th P.M. Sections 6 thru 8: All, Sections 17 thru 20: All, Section 30: All Township 4 North, Range 64 West, 6th P.M. Sections 1 thru 3: All, Sections 10 thru 15: All, Section 23: All, Section 25: All

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the above, has set the above-entitled matter for hearing on:

All owners and operators of leases in the Hambert Field are hereby requested to appear at the above-scheduled hearing and present information to the Commission in order to ascertain if the present spacing patterns in the field should be continued.

Pursuant to said hearing in the above-entitled matter, at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operation of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.
