Shannon,

I am reviewing the Form 2A location assessment for the New Cache FH SESE Pad 8-40D. Please address the following comments:

1. I changed the depth to water to 9 feet - see the static water level in water well 19956-F.
2. I changed the Sensitive Area Designation to Yes due to shallow ground water and the proximity of the location to several surface water bodies.
3. Conditions of Approval: Please acknowledge the following conditions of approval due to the proximity of the location to surface water and due to the presence of shallow ground water:

COA 1. Location is in a sensitive area because of close proximity to surface water, therefore, operator must ensure 110 percent secondary containment for any volume of fluids contained at well site during drilling and completion operations.

COA 2. The location is in a sensitive area due to the presence of shallow ground water and proximity to surface water. Therefore, the tank battery must be constructed with an impermeable liner.
