among other things, established 80-
acre drilling and spacing units for the
production of oil and/or gas from the
Codell formation underlying certain
lands in Adams, Boulder, Jefferson,
Larimer and Weld Counties, Colora-
do. The units consist of the E 1/2 and
W 1/2 or the N 1/2 and S 1/2 of a govern-
mental quarter section with the per-
mitted well located in the center of the
quarter-quarter section with a toler-
ance of 200 feet with the option to drill
an additional well in the undrilled 40-
acre tract.
On April 8, 1984, Skaer Enterprises,
Inc., by its attorney, filed with the
Commission an application for an or-
