On December 19, 1983, the Commission issued Order No. 407-1 which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil and/or gas from the Codell formation underlying certain lands in Adams, Boulder, Jefferson, Larimer and Weld Counties, Colorado. The units consist of the E½ and W½ or the N½ and S½ of a governmental quarter section with the permitted well located in the center of the quarter-quarter section with a tolerance of 200 feet with the option to drill an additional well in the undrilled 40-acre tract.

On April 8, 1984, Skaer Enterprises, Inc., by its attorney, filed with the Commission an application for an order deleting the following described lands in Larimer and Weld Counties, Colorado from the provisions of Order No. 407-1 and make said lands subject to the general rules and regulations of the Commission.
