NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On November 17, 1970, the Commission issued Order No. 232-1 by which 320-acre drilling and spacing units were established for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the 'J' Sand underlying lands in the Wattenberg Gas Spaced Area. Subsequent Orders extended the area and by Order No. 232-23, an additional well was allowed to be drilled on each 320-acre unit. The W $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 32, Township 1 North, Range 68 West, 6th P.M. has been designated a Unit. A well has been drilled in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 32, producing from the 'J' Sand and operated by Martin Exploration Management Company.

On July 1, 1987, Robert B. Mussack filed with the Commission a verified application for an order pooling his interest in the drilling and spacing unit consisting of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 32, Township 1 North, Range 68 West, 6th P.M. for the operation and development of the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the 'J' Sand underlying said unit, in accordance with 34-60-116 C.R.S. as amended.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the above, has scheduled the above-entitled matter for hearing on:

DATE: Monday, August 17, 1987

TIME: 9:00 a.m.

PLACE: Room 110, State Centennial Building, 1313 Sherman Street, Denver, Colorado 80203.

Pursuant to said hearing in the above-entitled matter at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operations of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.

Any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or to intervene should file with the Commission a written protest or a notice to intervene no later than August 12, 1987, briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. Such interested party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or notice to intervene to the person filing the application. A fee of forty-five dollars (\$45.00) shall accompany each document filed with the Commission.
