



Geologist Information

 Ownership: Fed Surface, Split Minerals
 SUA Status: EA Needed – maybe only CX since existing
 Spacing Units: Federal unspaced

Plan of Development

Access: Will use existing access
 Drilling: Efficiency rig
 Cuttings: On surface in northeast corner. Excess cuttings hauled to the SG Cuttings Pit next to the SG 22-32 pad.
 SIMOPS: Yes
 Completion: Frac from SG 34-28 with water storage on the SG Completions Pit. Will run a 10" water supply line from water storage area to SG 34-28 pad along pipeline ROW that is on CDOT ROW
 Flowback: Flow back on pad.
 Prod Equip: Production Equipment to be set along the west side of the access road.
 Pipeline: A new 12" gas/4" water line will be installed along access road. Old gas line will be removed. Gas line to be tied into 12" main line in state ROW. Water line does not have another line to tie-into yet but may in the future. No further disturbance is needed.
