NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

In Cause No. 407, the Commission established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil and/or gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell formation. Wells shall be located in the center of a 40-acre tract or quarter-section with a tolerance of 200 feet in any direction. All sections in Township 1 North, Range 68 West, 6th P.M. are included in Cause No. 407.

In Cause No. 232, the Commission established 320-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of gas from the "J" Sand in the Wattenberg Field with one well allowed for each unit to be located in the NE 1/4 and SW 1/4 and no closer than 990 feet to the boundaries of the quarter section. On August 21, 1979, the Commission issued Order No. 232-20 which allowed a second well to be drilled on each 320-acre unit. All sections in Township 1 North, Range 68 West, 6th P.M. are included in Cause No. 232.

On or about September 18, 1985, Amoco Production Company drilled and completed a well UPRR 43 Pan Am Y #1 at a location 680 feet FNL and 1985 feet FWL of Section 14, Township 1 North, Range 68 West, 6th P.M., Weld County, Colorado as a Codell/Niobrara producing well for the unit consisting of E 1/2 NW 1/4 of said Section 14. On June 2, 1989, Amoco Order No. 232-20 and allow the UPRR 43 Pan Am Y #1 to be recompleated into the "J" Sand as an exception location for the unit consisting of the N 1/2 Section 14.

Such interested party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or notice to intervene to the person filing the application. A fee of forty-five dollars (\$45.00) shall accompany each document filed with the Commission.
