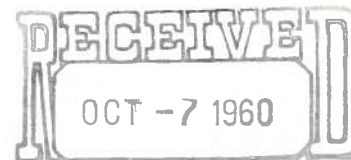

NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS  
AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On October 20, 1959, the Commission issued its Order No. 55-3 which, among other things, approved a Unit Agreement covering operations in the "D" and "J" sands, and also approved a water injection program for the "J" sand underlying the Xenia-West Unit Area, Washington County, Colorado.

On October 3, 1960, the Kingwood Oil Company, operator of the Xenia-West Unit, filed with the Commission an application for an order approving a proposed project for the injection of water into the "D" sand underlying said Xenia-West Unit Area, as defined by said Order No. 55-3 and the approved Unit Agreement.

Also, on October 3, 1960, the Kingwood Oil Company filed another application with the Commission, requesting permission to dually complete in the "D" and "J" sands, the Minkler No. 2 well located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 11, Township 2 North, Range 54 West of the 6th P. M., Washington County, Colorado, and to commingle the production therefrom.
