## NOTICE OF HEARING BEFORE THE OIL AND GAS CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF COLORADO CAUSE NO. 34

DOCKET NO. 0208-SP-10

IN THE MATTER OF THE PROMULGATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF FIELD RULES TO GOVERN OPERATIONS IN THE GREENWOOD FIELD, BACA COUNTY, COLORADO

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On July 14, 1954, the Commission issued Order No. 34-1, which, among other things, established 640-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of gas from the Topeka-Lansing Formation underlying lands in the Greenwood Field. By subsequent orders certain lands were added and deleted from the spaced area.

Such interested party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or intervention to the person filing the application. An original and nine (9) copies shall be filed with the Commission (Rule 503.f.). Pursuant to Rule 503.e., if a party who has received notice under Rule 503.b. wishes to receive further pleadings in the above-referenced matter, that party must file a protest or intervention in accordance with these rules. In accordance with the practices of the Commission, should no protests or interventions be filed in this matter by August 5, 2002, the Applicant may request that an administrative hearing be scheduled for the week of August 5, 2002.
