## NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On July 14, 1954, the Commission issued Order No. 34-1, which, among other things, established 640-acre drilling and spacing units for production of gas from the Topoka-Lansing Formation underlying the Greenwood Field. By subsequent orders certain lands were added and deleted from the spaced area.

In December 20, 1983, the Commission issued Order No. 34-15, which established 320-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of gas from the Topoka-Lansing Formation for the below-listed lands in the Greenwood Field.

In June 27, 2002, Sandlin Oil Corporation filed with the Commission a verified Application for an order to remove the below-listed lands from Order No. 34-1 and place the lands under the provisions of the Rules and Regulations of the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission. The applicant states that these lands are separated from the Greenwood Field by dry holes and removal of the lands would be beneficial for future exploration for the production of gas from the Topoka-Lansing Formation.

conformance with Rule 509, any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or to intervene on application should file with the Commission a written protest or intervention no later than August 5, 2002, briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. Such interested party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or application to the person filing the application. An original and nine (9) copies shall be filed with the Commission (Rule 503.1), in accordance with these rules. In accordance with the practices of the Commission, that party must file a protest or intervention in accordance with these rules. The Applicant may request that an administrative hearing be scheduled for the week of August 5, 2002.
