NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS
AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On July 14, 1954, the Commission issued Order No. 34-1 which established 640-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of gas from the Topeka-Lansing formation underlying certain lands in the Greenwood Field, Baca County, Colorado, with the permitted well located within 500 feet of the unit. Subsequent orders added and deleted certain lands from the spaced area.

On April 6, 1984, TXO Production Corporation, by its attorneys, filed with the Commission two (2) applications for an order granting exceptions to the permitted well location as provided for in Order NO. 34-1 and allow, 1. a well to be drilled at a location 600 feet from the south line and 600 feet from the east line Section 31, Township 32 South, Range 41 West, and, 2. a well to be drilled at a location 1980 from the south line and 600 feet from the west line of Section 32, Township 32 South, Range 41 West, and that they be the permitted wells for the unit upon which each is located.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the above, has scheduled the above-entitled matter for hearing on:

DATE: Monday, May 21, 1984.

TIME: 9:00 a.m.

PLACE: Room 110, State Centennial Building, 1313 Sherman Street, Denver, Colorado 80203.

Pursuant to said hearing in the above-entitled matter at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operations of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.

Any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application should file with the Commission a written protest no later than May 16, 1984, briefly stating the basis of the protest, and such interested party shall, at the same time, serve or mail a copy of the protest to the person filing the application.
