BEFORE THE OIL AND GAS CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF COLORADO CAUSE NO. 34

IN THE MATTER OF THE PROMULGATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF FIELD RULES TO GOVERN OPERATIONS IN THE GREENWOOD FIELD, BACA COUNTY, COLORADO.

NOTICE OF HEARING TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On July 14, 1954, the Commission issued its Order No. 34-1 for the Greenwood Field which, among other things, established 640-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of gas from the Topeka-Lansing formations. By subsequent Order Nos. 34-2, 34-8, and 34-9 certain lands were added and deleted from the spaced area.

On July 21, 1978, Texas Oil and Gas Corporation, by its attorneys, filed with the Commission an application for an order to delete from the spaced area of the Greenwood Field the following described lands in Baca County, Colorado, to-wit: Township 31 South, Range 42 West, 6th P. M. Section 26: All Section 34: All Section 35: All

Township 32 South, Range 42 West, 6th P. M. Section 2: All

and further providing that such area no longer be subject to the provisions of the orders in Cause No. 34 and be made subject to the general rules and regulations of the Commission.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, pursuant to the above, has scheduled the above-entitled matter for hearing on: DATE: Monday, August 21, 1978. TIME: 9:00 a. m.

PLACE: Room 110, State Centennial Building, 1313 Sherman Street, Denver, Colorado 80203.

Pursuant to said hearing in the above-entitled matter, at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operation of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.

Any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application should file with the Commission a written protest no later than August 16, 1978, briefly stating the basis of the protest, and such interested party shall at the same time serve or mail a copy of the protest to the person filing the application.
