On July 14, 1954, the Commis-
sion issued its Order No. 34-1 for
the Greenwood Field which,
among other things, established
640-acre drilling and spacing
units for the production of gas
from the Topeka-Lansing for-
mations. By subsequent Order
Nos. 34-2, 34-8, and 34-9 certain
lands were added and delet-
ed from the spaced area.

On July 21, 1978, Texas Oil
and Gas Corporation, by its at-
torneys, filed with the Commis-
sion an application for an order
to delete from the spaced area
of the Greenwood Field the
following described lands in
Baca County, Colorado, to-wit:

and further providing that such
area no longer be subject to
the provisions of the orders in
Cause No. 34 and be made sub-
ject to the general rules and
regulations of the Commission.

tion Commission of the State

briefly stating the basis of the
protest, and such interested par-
ty shall at the same time serve
or mail a copy of the protest to
the person filing the application.
