Bob:

The Sigg 1A (05-123-10887) was drilled in 1982 by Unioil. The well was plugged and abandoned in 1991 and prior to COGCC Rule 911. As a result, this site was not included in the Unioil Pit Inventory Report submitted in 1995.

During 2007, Petroleum Development Corp. (PDC) acquired multiple wells, associated equipment and leases in Larimer and Weld Counties from Unioil (Operator #90950). Unioil became a wholly owned subsidiary of PDC. The Sigg 1A was not part of this acquisition as it was previously plugged and abandoned.

Attached is additional information which includes:

- A Form 5 – Well Completion Report for the Sigg 1A dated 1983 (document #92976) which indicates 0 BWPD during the initial production test.
- An initial Form 10 for the Sigg 1A (document #92977) dated 1983 which indicates 0 BWPD during the new well test data.
- COGCC Field Inspection Reports for the Sigg 1A dated 6/86, 5/19/94, 11/1/06. The 6/86 report mentions that the “pit in need of screen cover”. The subsequent inspection in 1994 was conducted after the well was plugged and abandoned.
- Historic Aerial Photograph for the well and the tank battery (located south along WCR 16) from the 1990’s does not indicate a pit at the wellhead, at the tank battery or along the lease road.

Based on the field inspection report from 1986, there is evidence that a pit existed at this location. However, the well was plugged and abandoned in 1991 and the pit closed prior to implementation of Rule 911. As a result, PDC respectfully requests that the status of **Facility #118654** be changed to **CLOSED**.
