Bob:

The Campion 1 (05-069-06155) and the Campion 2 (05-069-06195) were drilled in 1983 by Unioil. As per COGCC Rule 911, Unioil submitted a pit inventory in 1995 which indicates that there was a 1400 gallon concrete vault at the subject tank battery location (see attached).

During 2007, Petroleum Development Corp. (PDC) acquired multiple wells, associated equipment and leases in Larimer and Weld Counties from Unioil (Operator #90950). Unioil became a wholly owned subsidiary of PDC. The Campion #1 was plugged and abandoned in 2002 and the Campion #2 was plugged and abandoned in 2009.

Attached is additional information which includes:

- A Form 5 – Well Completion Report for the Campion #1 (document #124886) which does not indicate any produced water during the initial flow-back test.
- A Form 5 – Well Completion Report for the Campion #2 (document #124894) which does not indicate any produced water during the initial flow-back test.
- An initial Form 10 for the Campion #1 dated 1983 (document #124885) which does not indicate any produced water on the new well test data.
- An initial Form 10 for the Campion #2 dated 1984 (document #124893) which does not indicate any produced water on the new well test data.
- COGCC Field Inspection Reports for the Campion #1 dated 1/4/89, 8/28/96, 9/18/00, 5/2/02, 6/5/02, 8/24/12; and for the Campion #2 dated 8/28/96, 9/18/00, 5/2/02, 4/22/08, 8/24/12 do not indicate any pits observed. In fact, the 8/28/96 inspection report confirms the presence of a concrete vault as indicated on the pit inventory record.

- Historic Aerial Photographs for both wells and the tank battery (located approx. 600' south of the Campion #1) from the 1990's, 2005, 2009 and 2011 do not indicate any pit at the wellheads, at the tank battery or along the lease road.

Based on the information provided, there is no evidence that a pit existed at this location. As a result, PDC respectfully requests that the status of **Facility #116044** be changed to **CLOSED**.
