

The Commission has heretofore issued its Order No. 30-7, which provides in part that the order shall be in effect until October 1, 1955, or until further order of the Commission, pursuant to notice and hearing. All operators and owners of working interests and all persons interested in the said field, are hereby required to appear at the hearing as set forth above, and to show cause, if any they have, why the Commission should not issue an order continuing the provisions of Order No. 30-7, or an order similar thereto.

Pursuant to said hearing in the above entitled matter, at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operation of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.
