hearing on:



show cause, if any they have, why
the Commission should not issue an
order continuing the provisions of
Order No. 30-7, or an order similar
thereto.

Pursuant to said hearing on the
above entitled matter, at the time
and place aforesaid, or at any ad-
journed meeting, the commission
will enter such orders as it deems
appropriate to prevent the waste
of oil and gas, either or both in
the operation of said field, and to
carry out the purposes of the sta-
