NOTICE OF HEARING TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, upon its own motion, has set the above entitled matter down for hearing on:

DATE: Tuesday, November 23, 1955

TIME: 10:00 a. m.
PLACE: Room 243, State Capitol Denver, Colorado

The Commission has heretofore issued its Order No. 30-8, which provides in part that the order shall be in effect until December 1, 1955, or until further order of the Commission, pursuant to notice and hearing.

The Commission has instituted this proceeding to promulgate new or revised rules and regulations in accordance with the Oil and Gas Conservation Act for the prevention of waste of oil and gas; and to do whatever else may be considered proper and within the powers of this Commission to carry out the purposes of said statute in respect to the "J" sand reservoir of the Little Beaver Field, Washington and Adams Counties, Colorado.

All operators and owners of working interests, and all persons interested in the said field, are hereby required to appear at the hearing as set forth above, and to submit testimony concerning the present production activities of wells completed in the "J" sand reservoir of the Little Beaver Field, Washington and Adams Counties, Colorado, and recommendations for new or revised rules and regulations and the reasons therefor.

Pursuant to said hearing in the above entitled matter, at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operation of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.
