Comes now Col-Tex Oil, Inc., and respectfully requests that a hearing be called to consider amendments to Order Number 30-8, Cause Number 30, in order to better protect correlative rights of owners of oil and gas interests than is provided in existing regulations. That such hearing should among other things consider:

- (1.) The definition of a gas well as one with a gas-oil ratio in excess of 10,000 to one.
- (2.) That gas wells so classified be allowed a maximum daily production of 300 MCF.
- (3.) That the maximum gas-oil ratio of oil wells be 2000 to one with a daily maximum production of 125 barrels of oil per day.
