Fay,

Based on review of the documentation provided in the Site Closure Report received by COGCC on February 15, 2013, the closure criteria for the former pits and related remediation of oily waste has been satisfied. The related pit facilities (ID #s 100304 & 100305) have been changed to closed status in the Colorado Oil & Gas Information System. The remediation project #4886 will remain open until the site has been revegetated in accordance with COGCC Rule 1004. When vegetation has been established that meets the final threshold requirements, either notify me directly that the location is ready for final inspection, or submit a Sundry Notice Form 4 indicating final reclamation is complete and the site is ready for inspection. After a satisfactory inspection is completed, the project will be changed to closed status and no further action will be required.

Please note that the Remediation #5164 for the nearby Gillham Pit Closure project also remains open pending notification that final surface reclamation/revegetation was completed. If the revegetation at the Schwake is successful this Spring, I would be happy to inspect both locations at the same time to hopefully move both projects to closed status.

A copy of the approved Sundry Form 4 is attached for your records. Thank you for providing the detailed and thorough report documenting the facility closure/remediation activities. Please give me a call if you have any questions.
