TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS  
AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On October 25, 1956, The Pure Oil Company filed with the Commission an application requesting that Order No. 26-25 be amended to provide that the basic allowable for each 160-acre gas spacing unit in the "D" sand in the Adena Field be established as 150,000 cubic feet of gas per day; that in the event of voluntary designation or creation of larger "D" sand gas units, the allowable for such larger unit be established as 150,000 cubic feet of gas per day multiplied by the number (not to exceed a maximum of four) of 160-acre "D" sand gas spacing units in the Adena Field lying within such larger unit; that all "D" sand wells be properly classified as oil or gas wells; and for such other rules and regulations as the Commission shall determine necessary or proper in the matter.


