## NOTICE OF HEARING

IN THE MATTER OF THE PRO-  
MULGATION AND ESTABLISH-  
MENT OF FIELD RULES TO  
GOVERN OPERATIONS IN THE  
'J' SAND OF THE ADENA  
FIELD, MORGAN COUNTY,  
COLORADO  
TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS  
AND TO WHOM IT MAY CON-

On July 31, 1958, the Commission issued its Order No. 26-30, subsequently amended, which, among other things, established a maximum allowable production of oil and gas from the 'J' sand pool of the Adena Field, and required periodic bottom-hole-pressure and gas-oil-ratio surveys.

On July 28, 1958, The Pure Oil Company, as Operator of the Adena 'J' Sand Unit, filed with the Commission an application requesting a hearing to determine the present maximum efficient rate of production of oil and gas from the Adena 'J' Sand Field, establish the allowable daily quantities of oil and gas to be produced from said field in accordance with such MER determination; and allocate such total field production among the separate producing leases in the field; and for such other and further relief as the Commission shall determine proper in this matter.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that The Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, pursuant to said application, has set the above entitled matter down for hearing on:
