

NOTICE OF HEARING BEFORE THE OIL AND GAS CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF COLORADO CAUSE NO. 26 IN THE MATTER OF THE PROMULGATION OF FIELD RULES TO GOVERN OPERATIONS IN THE "D" SAND OF THE ADENA FIELD, MORGAN COUNTY, COLORADO TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: On June 22, 1959, The Pure Oil Company filed with the Commission application for an order (a) amending Order No. 26-37 by increasing the maximum "D" sand allowable to 300,000 cubic feet of gas per day for each drilling and spacing "D" sand gas unit located within the following tracts in the Adena Field, Morgan County, Colorado: W 1/2 of Section 6, Township 14 North, Range 57 West; All of Sections 1 and 12, Township 1 North, Range 58 West; (b) making applicable the six-months allowable balancing periods heretofore prescribed by Rules (b), (c), (d) and (e) of Order No. 26-37; and (c) amending Rule 3 of Order No. 26-32 by substituting the phrase "the daily gas allowable for such well" in lieu of the phrase "One Hundred Fifty Thousand (150,000) cubic feet of gas" now contained in such rule; and that such other and further rules as the Commission shall deem proper be promulgated regarding such gas production. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that The Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, pursuant to said application, has set the above entitled matter for hearing on: DATE: Tuesday, July 21, 1959 TIME: 10:00 a.m. PLACE: Green Room, Albany Hotel 17th and Stout Denver, Colorado Pursuant to said hearing in the above entitled matter, at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operation of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.
