On September 2, 1959, Petroleum, Incorporated filed with the Commission an application for an order granting an exception to the "D" sand portion of the spacing pattern established by Order No. 26-1 issued January 19, 1954, which order was subsequently amended. Order No. 26-16 enlarged the Adena Field limits to include Section 25, Township 1 North, Range 53 West, the area involved in said application. The exception requested by Applicant is for the Goedert No. 1 well to be located in the center of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 25, instead of the center of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as now required.

All persons interested in the above matter are invited to appear and be heard on the above date.

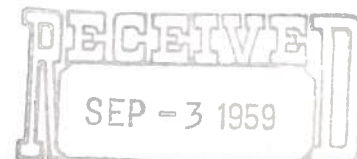
